COMMITTEE MEMBER CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

1. Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others.
2. Be professional in, and accept responsibility for your actions, your language, presentation and manners – committee members should act in the highest of standards
3. Resolve conflicts fairly and promptly through established procedures.
4. Maintain strict impartiality.
5. Be aware of your legal responsibilities.
6. Develop a positive sporting environment by allowing for the special needs of the players (especially children), by emphasising enjoyment and by providing appropriate development and competitive experiences.
7. Involve players in the planning, leadership, evaluation and decision-making relating to the activity.
8. Ensure activities, equipment and facilities are safe and appropriate to the ability or level of participating players. Activities, rules, equipment, length of games and training schedules should take into consideration the age, ability and maturity level of participating players.
9. Ensure that everyone (committee members, coaches, players, umpires, parents, spectators and officials) emphasise fair play in netball activities and games.
