SPECTATORS CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

- 1. Most players (in particular children) participate in netball activities for fun they are not participating for entertainment of spectators only.
- 2. Applaud good performance and efforts by all players when watching the game and congratulate both teams on their performance regardless of the game's outcome.
- 3. Respect the umpires and coaches' decisions if there is a disagreement follow the appropriate procedure in order to question the decision and teach children to do likewise.
- 4. Never ridicule of scold a player for making a mistake during a competition positive comments are motivational.
- 5. Condemn the use of violence in any form, be it by committee members, coaches, players, umpires or parents/guardians.
- 6. Show respect for your teams' coach, the umpire and opponents without them there would be no game.
- 7. Encourage players to play according to the rules and the official decisions and develop your own knowledge of the rules.
- 8. Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by refraining from using foul language, harassing committee members, coaches, players or umpires.
- 9. If you are asked by a committee member to leave the premises because of a breach of this code, respect that decision.
